The Commission Staff has reviewed the application filed by Bullitt Utilities, Inc. in the above case. This filing is rejected for the reasons set forth below.

Filing deficiencies pursuant to:

807 KAR 5:001

Section 4(3)

The filing does not contain the telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address of submitting party or attorney.

Section 4 (10)

The applicant did not redact tax identification numbers, financial account numbers, and electronic transfer numbers.

Section 14 (2)

The applicant did not attest that it is currently in good standing in the state of Kentucky.

Section 15 (2)

(b) The application did not include copies of franchises or permits from the proper public authority for the proposed construction.

(c) The application did not include a full description of the proposed location of the proposed construction, including a description of the manner in which same will be constructed, and the names of all public utilities, corporations, or persons with whom the proposed construction is likely to compete.

(d)(1) The application did not include three copies (one copy in portable document format on electronic storage medium and two copies in paper medium) of maps to suitable scale showing the location of the proposed construction, as well as the location to scale of like facilities owned by others located anywhere within the map area with adequate identification as to the ownership of the other facilities.

(d)(2) The application did not include plans and specifications and drawings of the proposed plant, equipment, and facilities.

(e) The application did not identify the manner in detail in which the applicant proposes to finance the proposed construction.

(f) The application did not include an estimate of the annual cost of operation after the proposed facilities are placed into service.

KRS 322.340

The engineering plans, specifications, drawings, plats and reports for the proposed construction must be prepared by a registered engineer, and signed, sealed, and dated by an engineer registered in Kentucky.

In addition to the deficiencies listed above, this application is also rejected for the failure to comply with KRS 278.180, which requires “notice to the commission, stating plainly the [rate] changes proposed to be made and the time when the changed rates will go into effect”; failure to utilize either an historical test period or a forward-looking test period as required by KRS 278.192; and failure to file any financial information, tariff sheets, or customer notice as required for any rate adjustment under either 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 16 and 17 or 807 KAR 5:076.
