- 1. Hardin County Water District No. 2 (the "Hardin County No. 2"), by counsel, hereby gives notice that it has filed a copy of the attached Customer Notice in the record in this proceeding.
- 2. The purpose of the Customer Notice is to provide notice to the current Elizabethtown water customers that Hardin County No. 2 is seeking approval from the Kentucky Public Service Commission (the "Commission") to implement the Elizabethtown Water Rate Tariff Schedule set forth in Elizabethtown Ordinance No. 07-2014 enacted on February 18, 2014 rather than charge the current Elizabethtown water customers the higher Hardin County No. 2 water rates.

- 3. The Ordinance provides a gradual 4-step transition from Elizabethtown's current water rates to Hardin County No. 2's current water rates (the "Rate Transition Plan").
- 4. Notice of the Rate Transition Plan has already been provided to the public by the news articles which appeared in the following editions of *The News-Enterprise*:

- 6. Additionally, notice of the Rate Transition Plan has been, or will be, provided in the following manner:

Notice is hereby given that Hardin County Water District No. 2 (the "Water District") has filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (see Case No. 2014-00289) seeking approval: (i) to incur a long-term debt for the purpose of acquiring Elizabethtown's Water System Assets; and (ii) to implement the Elizabethtown Water Rate Tariff Schedule set forth in Elizabethtown Ordinance No. 07-2014 enacted on February 18, 2014 and also shown below. These rates will be applicable to current Elizabethtown water customers and future customers receiving water service in the Elizabethtown Water Service Area. These rates will not apply to residents of Elizabethtown who are already customers of the Water District. The Elizabethtown Water Rate Tariff Schedule contains four (4) step rate increases. If approved by the Public Service Commission, Step 1 rates will become effective for water service rendered by the Water District on and after November 1, 2014. The other step increases will become effective on the dates shown below.

The **Step 1** rate increase will cause the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month to increase from \$24.10 to \$27.35. This is an increase of \$3.25 or 13.5%.

The **Step 2** rate increase will cause the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month to increase from \$27.35 to \$29.55. This is an increase of \$2.20 or 8.0%.

The **Step 3** rate increase will cause the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month to increase from \$29.55 to \$31.75. This is an increase of \$2.20 or 7.4%.

The **Step 4** rate increase will cause the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 5,000 gallons per month to increase from \$31.75 to \$33.95. This is an increase of \$2.20 or 6.9%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates set forth in Elizabethtown Ordinance No. 07-2014 enacted by the Elizabethtown City Council on February 18, 2014. As part of its agreement to purchase the Elizabethtown Water System Assets, the Water District agreed to seek approval from the Public Service Commission to implement the Elizabethtown Water Rate Tariff Schedule for the current Elizabethtown water customers and future water customers receiving water service in the Elizabethtown Water Service Area. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.
