
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for an Order granting a brief extension of time for EKPC to file its direct testimony and responses to the requests for information contained in Appendix B of the Commission's Order entered herein on February 5, 2015. Specifically, EKPC requests that it be allowed an additional four (4) business days (*i.e.*, until Thursday, February 26, 2015) to file its responses.

In support of this Motion, EKPC states that the recent and widespread inclement weather experienced throughout central Kentucky has resulted in decreased staff availability and, in turn, increased internal operational constraints. A relatively brief extension of time for EKPC to compile and finalize its responses will not result in prejudice or unreasonable delay, and thus EKPC asserts that it has shown good cause for the relief it requests.

WHEREFORE, EKPC respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order granting EKPC an extension of four (4) business days (*i.e.*, until February 26, 2015) to respond to the subject requests for information.
