**SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION OF WINDSTREAM SERVICES, LLC**

Windstream Services, LLC<sup>1</sup> ("Windstream"), on behalf of its competitive local exchange carrier affiliates, Windstream Norlight LLC and Windstream NuVox Indiana,, LLC (collectively "Windstream"), through its undersigned counsel and pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §214, and Section 63.71 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. §63.71, hereby files this Application to discontinue the provision of a particular service in the markets specified below. In support of this Application, Windstream submits the following information:

Windstream plans to discontinue the Affected Service (see sub-paragraph d, below) on or about April 20, 2020.

**c. Point of Geographic Areas of Service Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(3), (b)(2)):**

Affected Services will be discontinued in the Evansville and Jasper, IN and Bowling Green, Hartford, Henderson, Hopkinsville, Madisonville and Owensboro, KY areas.

**d. Brief Description of the Type of Service to be Affected (47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(4), (b)(2)):**

The service to be affected is TDM PRI ("the affected service").

**2. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (b)(3)):**

On December 30, 2019, Windstream sent by First Class U.S. Mail notice to all affected customers of the planned discontinuance. A copy of such notice is attached hereto as Attachment 1, which is compliant with, among other things, Section 63.71(a)(5) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(5).

**3. Regulatory Classification of Carrier (47 C.F.R. § 63.71 (a)(4)):**

Windstream is nondominant with respect to the services that it proposes to discontinue.

**4. Service:**

In accordance with Section 63.71(a)(1) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(1), Windstream is submitting a copy of this Application by First Class U.S. Mail to the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission and to the Office of Indiana Governor, Eric Holcomb; Public Service Commission and to the Office of Kentucky Governor, Andy Beshear; and also to the Secretary of Defense (at the address given in 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)).

**5. Additional Questions Regarding This Application May be Addressed to the Undersigned.**

## **6. Circumstances of Discontinuance.**

Windstream is decommissioning a legacy switch in the Evansville area for which full-service vendor support is no longer available. The legacy switch serves twenty-one (21) TDM PRI business customers. That service will not be available from the next generation Metaswitch to which other customers are having their services moved in a like-for-like fashion. The affected customers will be offered by Windstream a next generation version service as an alternative to the TDM PRI service they have been receiving. Windstream will continue to serve customers in each of these markets and geographic coverage will not be affected; however, the menu of services that have been available to customers served through the switch to be decommissioned will change. Windstream will assist affected customers, providing them with options for migrating to alternative Windstream services or to move services to another carrier.

These customers will not be unduly harmed because they are being provided ample notice of the discontinuance and are being offered alternative services to the ones being discontinued. Furthermore, customers have comparable options from other providers serving these locations.

## **7. Technology Transition**

Because the legacy service covered by this Application (i.e., TDM PRI service) includes voice service capability and cannot be provisioned from the next generation switch to which it would otherwise move, a technology transition<sup>4</sup> is involved. Windstream hereby confirms that it offers a stand-alone interconnected VoIP service throughout the affected service areas, and at least one other alternative stand-alone facilities-based wireline or wireless voice service is available from another unaffiliated provider throughout the affected service areas.<sup>5</sup>



## 7. Conclusion

Windstream believes that the proposed discontinuance is reasonable and necessary. As outlined herein, Windstream will take reasonable steps to assure that the discontinuance of the affected service is not unduly disruptive to the present or future public convenience and necessity. Accordingly, Windstream respectfully requests that the Commission permit it to discontinue the provision of the affected service to customers in the affected locations pursuant to Section 63.71.


