O R D E R

On April 16, 1982, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8373, approving certain rates and providing for adjustments of these rates on a quarterly basis in accordance with the provisions of the Gas Cost Adjustment clause set forth therein.

On May 29, 1982, The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("Union") filed its initial quarterly gas cost adjustment which is to become effective July 1, 1982, and is to remain in effect until October 1, 1982. The net overall effect of this gas cost adjustment is a reduction of gas cost of 1.08 cents per 100 cubic feet.

The Commission has accepted Union's proposal in the Gas Cost Adjustment clause as applied in the adjustment of rates in this Order. The establishing of a Base Rate, which remains constant, and the Gas Cost Adjustment, which is variable and pertains only to the cost of gas, is a different procedure from past purchased gas adjustments approved by the Commission.

In either methodology the overall effect of this adjustment would have been the same.

After reviewing the evidence of record and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) The gas cost adjustment submitted by Union should be approved by the Commission.

(2) The Commission should allow Union to place into effect the rates in Appendix A for billings on and after July 1, 1982.

(3) The Base Rate for each rate class in Appendix A should become the firm base rate for each rate class.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

(1) The information furnished this Commission by Union on May 29, 1982, and revised on June 9, 1982, constitutes compliance with the Commission's Order in Case No. 8373.

(2) The gas cost adjustment in Appendix A be and it hereby is approved to be effective for billings on and after July 1, 1982.

(3) The Base Rate for each rate class be and it hereby is fixed as the firm Base Rate for each rate class on and after July 1, 1982.
