ORDER

On August 26, 1982, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Isaacs filed a complaint with the Commission against the McKinney Water Association. The complaint alleged that the McKinney Water Association had improperly terminated their water service as a result of the Isaacs' failure to pay a disputed bill. After an investigation, the Commission directed its staff to instruct the McKinney Water Association to reconnect the Isaacs' water service. This was done by a letter from our director of engineering on September 27, 1982. Based upon further investigation, the Commission has determined that an evidentiary hearing will be necessary in this matter.

The Commission HEREBY ORDERS that Mr. and Mrs. Paul Isaacs and the McKinney Water Association shall appear at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, on October 11, 1982, at 10:00 A.M., E.D.T., for a public hearing on this complaint.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the McKinney Water Association shall not terminate water service to the Isaacs' residence prior to a final order from the Commission in this matter.
