On December 2, 1982, the Commission received a letter (Motion) from Jackson Purchase Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") requesting a deviation from 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1.(9), which requires that the monthly fuel adjustment and supporting data shall be filed with the Commission ten days before it is scheduled to go into effect. Jackson Purchase bills its customers commencing the first of each month. In support of its request, Jackson Purchase states that two accountants recently left thereby causing the delay in filing the monthly fuel data.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the Motion should be sustained for good cause shown.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion of Jackson Purchase be and it hereby is sustained.
