O R D E R

On April 22, 1983, East Laurel Water District ("East Laurel") filed its response to the Commission's Order, dated April 15, 1983, requesting the filing of additional information. In response to Items 2 and 3 of that Order, East Laurel filed a statement showing 104,762,300 gallons of water purchased during the 12-month period ending December 31, 1982, and 93,224,300 gallons sold during the same period. East Laurel's calculations of its purchased water adjustment shows 70,797,800 gallons purchased and 62,984,700 gallons sold during this period.

Further, East Laurel did not file evidence that it has notified its customers of the proposed rate revision as requested in Item 4 of the Commission's Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that East Laurel shall file an original and eight copies of the following information with the Commission by May 9, 1983:

1. Reconciliation of water purchases and sales.
2. Evidence that East Laurel has notified its customers of the proposed rate revision.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in the event the above information is not timely filed, the Commission may dismiss the case without prejudice absent a Motion for Extension of Time for good cause.
