O R D E R


On September 8, 1983, Fancy Farm Water District, by counsel, filed its Motion for Extension of Time (until September 22, 1983) to advise to whom the contract was awarded for construction of the well and the reasons therefor. The Motion states that the reason for the requested extension is that the engineer is still investigating the low bid to determine whether a mistake was made and also to investigate the low bidder's references.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, finds that the Motion should be sustained for good cause shown.
