O R D E R

On June 10, 1988, Meade County Water District ("Meade") filed a request with the Commission seeking approval to increase its bulk water sales rate.

On July 22, 1988, the Commission issued an Interim Order approving Meade's proposed bulk water sales rate subject to final review of its operating revenues and expenses.

In reviewing Meade's operating revenues and expenses it was determined that the increase in the bulk water sales rate would not result in Meade collecting an excessive amount of operating revenue.

The Commission, after consideration of the evidence of record, and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that the bulk water sales rate in the amount of \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The bulk sales rate of \$4.50 per 1,000 gallons be and it hereby is approved.

2. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Meade shall file its revised tariff setting out the bulk water sales rate approved herein.
