O R D E R

On February 15, 1995, AmeriConnect, Inc. ("AmeriConnect") filed an application with the Commission to become a reseller of common carrier services. AmeriConnect's application contained a tariff with rates to be effective beginning March 17, 1995. The Commission suspended the operation of these tariffs until August 16, 1995. In response to a March 31, 1995 data request, AmeriConnect disclosed it had billed approximately \$80,000 during 1992 through 1994 for intrastate telecommunication services to the public in Kentucky. The Commission initiated a show cause proceeding regarding these unauthorized billings.<sup>1</sup> To date, this matter has not been resolved. Accordingly, the Commission hereby rejects AmeriConnect's proposed tariffs.




The Commission, having considered the evidence and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that AmeriConnect's tariffs shall be rejected at this time.


