O R D E R

On October 4, 2006, Commission Staff served its first information request on Farmdale Development Corporation ("Farmdale") to be answered within 14 days from the date of the request. Farmdale was asked to provide information concerning each item proposed to be repaired or replaced as noted in its amended application. Specifically, Farmdale was asked to describe the repair or replacement that will be performed and to provide bids or estimates from three non-affiliated sources to support each of its cost estimates.

Thereafter, Farmdale requested an extension of time to respond to the information request. By Order dated October 20, 2006, the Commission granted Farmdale an extension of time until November 20, 2006. By motion received November 21, 2006, Farmdale requested a second extension of 20 days to respond to the information request, stating that it "has requested additional bids on items needing repair and/or maintenance, but has not yet received all of the responsive bids."

The Commission finds that Farmdale has presented sufficient grounds to justify granting a second extension of time within which to respond to Commission Staff's information request.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Farmdale's request for a second extension of time of 20 days within which to respond to Commission Staff's information request is granted.
2. Farmdale shall file complete and precise responses to Commission Staff's information request on or before December 11, 2006, and shall provide a copy of its filing to all other parties of record.
