O R D E R

On November 1, 2006, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("East Kentucky Power") filed a notice of intent to file an application for approval of the construction of a 345 kV transmission line in Clark, Madison, and Garrard Counties, Kentucky. However, in a letter received by the Commission on April 20, 2007, the Applicant stated that, it would not be able to file its application within the six-month timeline required by 807 KAR 5:120, Section 1(1). EKPC stated that it was, therefore, filing a renewal of its notice of intent to file an application for approval of the construction of a 345 kV transmission line in Clark, Madison, and Garrard Counties, Kentucky.

On May 22, 2007, East Kentucky Power Cooperative filed its application for approval of the construction of a transmission line in Clark, Madison, and Garrard counties, Kentucky. On June 1, 2007, the Commission issued a preliminary procedural schedule. Since issuance of that Order, no persons have requested a local hearing in this case. However, two persons have been granted limited intervenor status.

Given the particular facts of this case, where the proposed transmission line will cross through parts of three counties, where the Commission has received two letters from the public voicing opposition to the proposed siting of the transmission line, and where two persons who wrote to the Commission opposing the siting of the transmission line have been granted limited intervenor status, the Commission finds that a hearing to receive public comments should be set for Thursday, August 2, at 5:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in Room B of the Perkins Conference Center at Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky.

In light of the interest in this case, the Commission also finds that a hearing for cross-examination of witnesses should be scheduled for August 22, 2007, at the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A local hearing to receive public comments is scheduled for Thursday, August 2, at 5:30 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time, in Room B of the Perkins Conference Center at Eastern Kentucky University, 521 Lancaster Avenue, Richmond, Kentucky.
2. A hearing for the purpose of cross-examining witnesses is scheduled for August 22, 2007, beginning at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky.
3. The attached revised procedural schedule shall apply.
