Enclosed please find a copy of Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation's ("Jackson Energy") Confidentiality Request for Jackson Energy received on February 23, 2007 (the "Request"). The Request is signed by yourself on behalf of Jackson Energy. As you may be aware, Kentucky law prohibits corporations from practicing law. Kentucky State Bar Association v. First Federal Savings & Loan Assoc. of Covington, Ky., 342 S.W.2d 397 (1961). The practice of law is broadly defined in Kentucky Supreme Court Rule 3.020. The filing of a request for confidentiality is a service involving legal knowledge or advice within the context of the rule.

Jackson Energy may, of course, have counsel submit a petition for confidentiality in accordance with 807 KAR 5:001(7). In the meantime, we will hold the information confidential for twenty (20) calendar days from this date, after which, in the absence of a properly filed petition of confidentiality, the information will become publicly available.

Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation, pursuant to KRS 61.870-874, the Kentucky Open Records Act, KRS 61.878, and all other applicable law, petitions the Kentucky Public Service Commission to grant confidential status to any and all information disclosed to the PSC in Administrative Case No. 2006-00494 in the response of Jackson Energy to the second data request of the PSC in that matter. The requested confidential information, concerns the expenses, long term plans, and other matters of a confidential and proprietary nature. These records fall within an exception of the Open Records Act, as set forth by KRS 61.878(c), in that these records were confidentially disclosed to an agency or required by an agency to be disclosed to it, generally recognized as confidential or proprietary, which if openly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to competitors or potential claimants of the entity that disclosed the records. These materials should be treated as both confidential and proprietary.

Wherefore, Jackson Energy Cooperative Corporation requests confidentiality for the disclosure to the PSC of its response to the second data request of the PSC in Administrative Case No. 2006-00494.
