OWEN COUNTY FISCAL COURT

Resolution

WHEREAS, Kentucky-American Water Company has filed an Application with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky seeking approval to build a water treatment plant near Pool 3 on the Kentucky River, in Owen County, Kentucky, Case No. 2007-00134, and

WHEREAS, the Bluegrass Water Supply Commission has entered into an Agreement with Kentucky-American Water Company for the performance of incremental engineering design work necessary to increase the water treatment plant capacity from 20 million gallons a day to 25 million gallons of water per day, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky-American Water Company currently serves more than 3,280 customers with potable water and more than 885 customers with wastewater services in Owen County, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky-American Water Company operates a water treatment plant and a wastewater treatment plant in Owen County, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the services rendered by Kentucky-American Water Company in Owen County, Kentucky, have met or exceeded all reasonable expectations, and

WHEREAS, the new plant will ultimately serve Owen County in the near future, and

WHEREAS, Kentucky-American Water Company's Application will solve Central Kentucky's raw and potable water deficiencies for a reasonable time,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the concern that the Owen County Fiscal Court has for the raw and potable water deficits in Central Kentucky, and in appreciation for the service rendered by Kentucky-American Water Company to its customers in Owen, Gallatin and Grant Counties, be it

RESOLVED, that the Owen County Fiscal Court endorses the use of Pool 3 of the Kentucky River by Kentucky-American Water Company and the Bluegrass Water Supply Commission as a source of raw water for regional use and the Application of Kentucky-American Water Company filed with the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky seeking approval to build a water treatment plant near Pool 3 and the construction of potable water transmission facilities associated therewith.
