Pursuant to the Commission's Order dated May 25, 2007, and the Procedural Schedule set forth therein, BellSouth Telecommunications Inc., d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T Kentucky"), makes the following filing.

On June 1, 2007, after the Commission's Order was issued, AT&T Kentucky filed its Motion to Dismiss and Answer in this case requesting the Commission to dismiss the case for lack of jurisdiction. In addition, on June 8, 2007, pursuant to the Procedural Schedule, AT&T Kentucky advised the Commission that it does not believe a formal hearing is necessary, and that oral argument on the legal issues presented would be sufficient. Therefore, AT&T Kentucky requested that the Commission revise the Procedural Schedule to allow for oral argument to address AT&T Kentucky's Motion to Dismiss, and in the event the Commission denies that motion, the remaining legal issues before the Commission.

For the reasons discussed above, AT&T Kentucky believes oral argument rather than an informal conference or a hearing in this matter would be sufficient and hereby reiterates its request for oral argument in this case.
