
Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky that the rural local exchange carrier complainants (the "RLECs") in the above-referenced matter intend to oppose the motions for dismissal and temporary suspension filed by Windstream Kentucky East, Inc. and Windstream Kentucky West, Inc. (collectively, "Windstream").
