
The LFUCG objects to Louisville Water Company's motion. Louisville Water Company intervened with full knowledge of the procedural schedule, and to date it has offered nothing more than a conceptual proposal. Given that the issue of the water supply deficit remains unresolved years (and several PSC cases) after being identified, the LFUCG has a significant concern with opening the door to a further delay on a decision, and has filed a motion to this effect in conjunction with this response.

For the foregoing reasons, the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government respectfully requests that the motion be denied.
