

**CITY OF FALMOUTH
ORDINANCE NO. 2007-71.19**

AN ORDINANCE DECREASING WHOLESALE WATER RATES TO THE EAST PENDLETON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO \$1.98 PER THOUSAND GALLONS, AND TO THE PENDLETON COUNTY WATER DISTRICT TO \$1.98 PER THOUSAND GALLONS, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, AND BASED UPON COMPROMISE OF A DISPUTED RATE INCREASE CASE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FALMOUTH:

Section 1. That Section 50.40 of the Code of Ordinance, Subsection E., authorizes the Falmouth City Council to contract on an individual basis for the provision of municipal utility services, as authorized by Kentucky Revised Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service Commonwealth of Kentucky, which includes contracts with the East Pendleton County Water District and the Pendleton County Water District, respectively.

Section 2. That the City of Falmouth and the East Pendleton County Water District and the Pendleton County Water District are parties to a disputed water rate increase case, #2006-00403, Commonwealth of Kentucky, Public Service Commission, on which an agreement has been reached, and all of which has been taken into account in the establishment of wholesale water rates.

Section 3. Based on the agreement to compromise, the wholesale water rates to the wholesale customers of the City of Falmouth water system be and hereby are established as follows:

a) To the East Pendleton County Water District:

\$1.98 per thousand gallons

b) To the Pendleton County Water District:

\$1.98 per thousand gallons

Section 4. That the Clerk of the City of Falmouth be and hereby is authorized and directed to provide a certified copy of this ordinance, to the East Pendleton County Water District, to the Pendleton County Water District, and to the Public Service Commission of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Rate Division, upon its enactment, approval, and publication as required by law.

Section 5. The effective date of the rates established herein shall be immediately, there being an emergency, to wit, the establishment of higher rates by operation of law on June 23, 2007.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately, upon its passage, and approval, and shall be published as soon as possible.




