I am writing to express opposition to the proposed cell tower placement at 906 Old Perryville Loop, Springfield, Kentucky.

My concerns are as follows:

Visual impact on scenic and farmland views from Hwy. 150, a major access road in the county

Environmental degradation from access roads, buildings, and 320 foot tower placed on farm acreage

Placement of significant structures in farm areas without county wide oversight for business operations outside of the city limits of Springfield.

I am not opposed to cell tower placement per se, but respect my neighbors objections to the adjacent placement of the tower to their homes and support oversight by a county government committee for all significant business operations and structures outside of the city limits of Springfield, in order to minimize impact on the residents of the county, and to establish control of growth in ways that preserve the county rural culture.
