Memorandum for Informal Conference held on February 11, 2008

In accordance with the Commission's December 26, 2007 Order ("December 26 Order") in this matter, an informal conference was held on February 11, 2008 at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky. Present were members of Commission Staff and representatives for Kentucky RSA #3 ("Kentucky RSA #3). The attendance list is attached to this memorandum and is incorporated herein by reference.

The purpose of this conference was to discuss the nature and purpose of Kentucky RSA #3's petition for review of the utility assessments of pre-paid wireless providers. This informal conference followed Kentucky RSA #3's submission of responses to the Commission's data request, as issued in the December 26 Order. Commission Staff and Kentucky RSA #3 discussed the nature of utility assessments, wholesale and retail revenues and the differences in interstate and intrastate revenue for telecommunications companies. Commission Staff and Kentucky RSA #3 also discussed pre-paid wireless sales transactions, as conducted by Kentucky RSA #3, compared to pre-paid wireless sales transactions, as conducted by companies such as TracFone and Virgin Mobile. Commission Staff also briefly discussed the scope of Commission regulation over wireless companies and pre-paid telecommunications providers.

Kentucky RSA #3 stated that within the coming days it would submit written notice to the Commission as to its position on the status of this case.

There being no further items for consideration, the informal conference thereafter adjourned.
