
Dear Mr. Derouen:

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") submits for filing its amended response to Brandenburg Telephone Company's ("Brandenburg") Data Request No. 6 and Data Request 22. The response to Data Request No. 6 was designated by the Commission as confidential. *See* letter dated October 1, 2008 from Stephanie Stumbo, copy attached. The response to Data Request 22 is not so designated. In doing so, Sprint re-states and fully preserves its objections with respect to Data Request No. 6.

The purpose of this amended response is to provide additional information and clarification to the discovery responses because Sprint has become aware that its original responses were either incomplete or require clarification with regard to wireless-originated traffic.

When Sprint originally filed its responses to these data requests on August 29, 2008, the final paragraph on the second page of the cover letter was a response to a letter filed with the Commission on August 14, 2008, by Ms. Holly Wallace. To minimize confusion the Commission disregard that paragraph and refer instead to the enclosed supplemental response and the testimony of Julie Walker, which contain a complete description of the methodology applied to generate PIUs for wireless-originated traffic.

DATA REQUEST NO. 22:

Is Sprint's network configured in a manner that would permit it to route a wireline or wireless call originating in Kentucky and terminating to an end-user physically located in Kentucky through a switch located outside of Kentucky so that the call would appear to be interstate in nature? Please explain.

SPRINT'S RESPONSE: No, Sprint's nationwide network is interconnected such that calls from/to similar geographic locations can take differing routes across the network to achieve successful call completion. Regardless of the intermediate routing across Sprint's network, the information representing geographic call origination and termination locations (data used to determine jurisdiction) is not changed.

To clarify Data Request response #22, for wireless-originated calls only, as detailed in Julie Walker's testimony, cell sites can be connected to switches in other states.

The call detail information created when the call is made and transmitted in an SS7 record will identify the location of the switch, not the location of the cell site.

In no case does Sprint's long distance network change or strip the call detail information populated by the originating carrier.

Dear Mr. Hughes:

The Public Service Commission has received Sprint Communications Company's Petition for confidential treatment requesting to protect as confidential certain information contained in certain attachments to the discovery Responses. The information is described as Confidential Attachments DR-2, DR-6, DR-7, DR-11 and DR-15 and includes the precise physical location and other identifying information related to infrastructure, wireline and wireless switches, customer information, call detail records and cell sites.

Based upon a review of the information, the Commission has determined that the following items are not entitled to confidential treatment:

Attachment DR-15:

- (1) Field descriptions
- (2) NPAs in service by number


This information does not meet the criteria for confidentiality and therefore, confidential protection is denied.

The information denied confidentiality will be withheld from public inspection for 20 days from the date of this letter. If you disagree with the Commission's decision, you may seek rehearing with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter under the provision of KRS 278.400.

Based upon the Commission's review of the information contained in Responses DR-2, DR-6, DR-7, DR-11 and portions of DR-15 not listed above, the Commission has determined that this information does meet the criteria for confidentiality and therefore, is entitled to the protection requested on the grounds relied upon in the Petition and should be withheld from public inspection.

If the information becomes publicly available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, Sprint Communications Company, is required by 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(9)(a), to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
