

NOTICE

Richmond Utilities ("RU") has filed a proposed rate schedule which will increase the rate for water service provided as follows:

	<u>Current Rate</u>	<u>Proposed Rate</u>	<u>% Difference</u>
Kirksville Water Association	\$2.02/100 Cu Ft	\$2.08/100 Cu Ft	2.8% Increase
Madison County Utility District	\$2.02/100 Cu Ft	\$2.08/100 Cu Ft	2.8% Increase

The proposed effective date is July 1, 2008.

The Kentucky River Authority has increased their "water use fee". Effective April 1, 2008, the rate will increase to \$0.065/100 cu ft. The change will be reflected on bills reflecting usage from April 1st.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by RU. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Any corporation, association, or person with a substantial interest in the matter may, by written request, within thirty (30) days after publication or mailing of this notice of the proposed rate changes request to intervene. Intervention may be granted beyond the thirty (30) day period for good cause shown.
