This Ordinance authorizes the issuance by the Ohio County Hospital Project, an agency and instrumentality of the County of Ohio, of 2010 (Ohio County Hospital Project) in a principal amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 to provide funds to finance the acquisition, construction and improvement of a hospital facility within the County (the "Project") to be leased to the Ohio County Hospital Project, a Kentucky nonprofit corporation the Hospital Corporation, under Chapter 58 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes. The lease payments to be made by the Hospital Corporation to the County of Ohio shall be secured by the sublease payments to be made by the Hospital Corporation to the Ohio County Hospital Project (the "Agreement") among the Corporation and the County of Ohio.

That, Whereas, the City of Hardinsburg desires to create and provide for City parks to be used and enjoyed by the general public; and
 That, Whereas the City believes that it is necessary and prudent to promulgate certain rules and regulations for the general operations of the parks and to regulate certain conduct and activities within the parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

No person shall enter, remain in, or be upon any public park in the city between 12:00 midnight and 4:00 a.m. or as posted in the park. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any motor vehicle in excess of the posted speed limit in a park. All traffic shall operate and/or park only in the manner designated and marked by appropriate signage in parks. No person shall possess or have on his or her person any alcoholic beverage, illegally controlled substance, gun, firearm, knife or other weapon in a city park.
