**BOWLING GREEN** — Bowling Green City Commissioners have taken a preliminary vote to ban smoking in the south-central Kentucky city.

WBKO-TV reports commissioners voted 3-2 Tuesday night in favor of the ban that would prohibit smoking in all public and work places. Another vote is required before the ban is approved. A specially-called city commission meeting is scheduled Monday for a final vote on the measure. If city commissioners approve it, the smoking ban would take effect 90 days later.

A fire gutted the buildings and destroyed the third floor and roof of the four homes on Oct. 20, 2009, killing resident Lelia Burns, 57.

The fire and death of Burns stunned the neighborhood. An investigation by the Covington Fire Department never determined a cause.

Many wanted the historic 120-year-old homes to be restored and raised money for the effort. Residents raised \$2,000 at a fundraiser at Otto's restaurant in MainStrasse, Hastings said. The Kentucky

Heritage Council granted the project \$5,000. The Local Initiatives Support Corporation granted \$5,000 and gave the developers a \$50,000 interest-free loan, she said. This money helped put a roof on the building to protect it from the elements, she said.

"Everybody was saddened to see the fire happen," Hastings said. "One of the homeowners died in the fire. Folks really came together."

The refurbished homes no longer have a third floor, which was too badly damaged, but retain many of the original fixtures, Kreutzjans said. He hopes to sell the


