ORDER

The Notice of Filing Proofs of Publication filed by Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") on March 18, 2011 indicates that notice of the public hearing scheduled in this matter for March 22, 2011 was timely published in newspapers in the service territory of Kentucky Power except the newspaper in Knott County, Kentucky. The *Troublesome Creek Times*, a newspaper in Knott County, Kentucky, failed to publish notice of that hearing. Although the hearing was held as scheduled on March 22, 2011, the Commission finds that an additional hearing should be scheduled to provide an opportunity for customers in Knott County, Kentucky to provide comments on the fuel adjustment clause issues in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A public hearing shall be held on May 3, 2011 at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky to allow customers in Knott County, Kentucky to examine the application of the fuel adjustment clause of Kentucky Power Company for the period November 1, 2008 through October 31, 2010. Customers interested in attending this hearing shall notify

the Commission in writing of their intent to attend no later than April 29, 2011. If no notice of intent to attend is received by that date, the hearing shall be cancelled.

- 2. Not less than 7 days nor more than 21 days prior to the scheduled hearing, Kentucky Power shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation in its service territory of Knott County, Kentucky, notice of the May 3, 2011 hearing, including the due date for filing notices of intent to attend, and stating that the hearing shall be cancelled if no notice to attend is filed by April 29, 2011.
- 3. Kentucky Power shall file proof of publication of its notice for the hearing with the Commission no later than April 29, 2011.
 - 4. The official record of the proceeding shall be by video only.
