

Witness: Michael E. Hornung

- Q-1. The Companies' response to Initial Interrogatories on Behalf of CAC, Question 2, appears to be applicable to Louisville Gas and Electric Company. Could you please describe – more specifically than the response previously provided to Question 2 – the intake process by which eligible Kentucky Utilities Customers are identified, eligibility confirmed, and Customers enrolled in the WeCare low-income residential weatherization program?
- A-1. Throughout its service territory, KU seeks to work with community action agencies and their networks to identify eligible customers, confirm eligibility, and enroll them in WeCare.
