On January 4, 2012 at approximately 10:00 a.m. an informal conference was convened at the Commission offices. A formal hearing in this matter had been scheduled to commence at 10:00 a.m. January 4, 2012, but was cancelled by Order of December 21, 2011. The December 21, 2011 Order directed Kentucky Power to publish a notice of cancellation of hearing in those newspapers where notice had been published stating that the hearing was cancelled by the terms of the December 21, 2011 Order. On January 4, 2012, Mr. Dwight Jett appeared at the Commission offices. Commission staff notified counsel for Kentucky Power Company by telephone of this. A list of attendees is attached.

Mr. Jett voiced his concerns about the potential for eminent domain proceedings and the manner in which his property was proposed to be divided. Kentucky Power indicated that an eminent domain proceeding is their last resort and that they prefer not to proceed in such a manner. Kentucky Power will have their right of way agent contact Mr. Jett concerning this matter. Mr. Jett indicated that he would file written comments for the record. Kentucky Power indicated it had no objections to Mr. Jett filing comments.
