

ORDER

Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") has petitioned for rehearing on the Commission's Order of April 25, 2013. Finding that Kentucky-American has raised issues that require further study and that the merits of its petition cannot be addressed satisfactorily without further study, the Commission finds that Kentucky-American's petition should be granted for the limited purpose of further considering the questions raised in the petition. The Commission expects to issue a decision on these issues within 30 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Kentucky-American's petition for rehearing is granted for the purpose of allowing the Commission additional time to address the merits of its petition.
