Pursuant to Commission order, an informal conference ("IC") was held on April 19, 2013. A copy of the conference attendance list is attached. The conference was held pursuant to the procedural schedule issued in this case for the purpose of discussing issues relating to the Commission's consideration of the implementation of Smart Grid and Smart Meter technologies. As directed, representatives of each of the jurisdictional utilities made parties to this proceeding were in attendance. Also, in attendance were representatives of two Intervenors, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention ("AG"), and the Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties, Inc. ("CAC"). One individual participated by telephone. Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers was not represented.

The conference began with opening remarks by Vice Chairman James W. Gardner followed by an overview by Commission Staff of previous cases in which Smart Grid issues were considered by the Commission. That discussion was followed by a discussion of the status of the current case and the potential next steps including using a collaborative approach to address Smart Grid and Smart Meter issues in this case. After discussion and comments regarding a collaborative effort the parties broke into smaller groups for separate discussions. A copy of the Agenda is also attached to this memorandum.

After the breakout discussions, the parties reassembled and the IC continued. On behalf of the parties, counsel for Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company stated that the parties wished to pursue a collaborative effort. The parties plan to submit a joint filing by May 20, 2013 with a recommendation of the topics the collaborative will address, a proposed schedule, and the manner in which the intervening parties and Commission Staff will participate in the collaborative. The joint filing will also recommend that the Commission not require adoption of the Smart Grid Investment Standard and the Smart Grid Information Standard. The joint filing will address the potential next steps raised during the IC.

Counsel for East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") stated that it is likely that some but not all of EKPC's member-owners will actively participate in the collaborative, but advised that those members who will participate would represent a good cross-section of the EKPC system as a whole. Counsel for Big Rivers Electric Corporation ("Big Rivers") stated that it is likely that all three of Big Rivers' member-owners will participate in the collaborative. The joint filing will address participation by the distribution cooperatives.

The IC concluded with a Staff explanation that a memo summarizing the IC that will also include the statements of counsel regarding the proposed collaborative will be issued for comment by all parties.

The IC was then adjourned.
