Motion To Amend Application

Kentucky Power Company moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 3(5) to amend its Application in this proceeding to accumulate and defer for review and recovery in the Company's next base rate proceeding the costs associated with a fifth 2012 Major Event storm. In support of its motion, Kentucky Power states:

- 1. Kentucky Power filed its application in this proceeding on September 28, 2012. In its Application, the Company sought an order permitting it to accumulate and defer for review and recovery in the Company's next base rate proceeding the costs associated with four 2012 Major Event storms.
- 2. Beginning on October 29, 2012, Kentucky Power's service territory was struck by a snow storm associated with Hurricane Sandy. The storm qualified as a Major Event storm.

 The heavy, wet snow caused substantial damage to the Company's distribution facilities and produced significant service outages. The Company incurred \$702,525 of incremental operational and maintenance expenses that would not have been incurred but for the storm.
- 3. The values listed in the amended Application for the four 2012 Major Event storms that were a part of the September 28, 2012 original Application have been updated to

conform to the most recent information available to the Company. The same updated information was provided in the Company's December 7, 2012 Supplemental Response to Staff's Second Data Request, Item No. 5.

Wherefore, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests leave to file its amended Application.
