

**MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE OF
KENTUCKY INDUSTRIAL UTILITY CUSTOMERS, INC.**

Pursuant to the unanimous agreement of the Parties,¹ Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. ("KIUC") respectfully moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") to amend the existing procedural schedule in the above-captioned case. The existing procedural establishes, *inter alia*, the following deadlines:

03/15/13	Kentucky Power Responses to Supplemental Requests for Information
03/25/13	Intervenor Testimony
04/08/13	Requests for Information to Intervenors

In light of the scope and complexity of this case, the voluminous amount of information to be produced, reviewed, and/or analyzed by the Parties, and the unanimous agreement of the Parties to the proposed amended procedural schedule, KIUC submits that good cause exists for the Commission to amend the procedural schedule and establish the following deadlines:



WHEREFORE, KIUC requests that the Commission adopt the proposed amended procedural schedule, which will not unduly delay the resolution of the above-captioned proceeding.
