Dear Mr. Derouen:

This is to request that the Commission revise its Order of November 20, 2012 in the referenced case to accept the purchased water adjustment factor of \$1.31 per 1,000 gallons as originally proposed by the District. The District recognizes that the use of an adjustment factor of \$1.31 per 1,000 gallons allows slightly less than full recovery of the increase in sewage treatment costs, but prefers this factor.

The District was unaware of the PSC's procedure to round up a small fraction of one cent. Therefore, assuming that the \$1.31 increase would be approved, the District began providing notification by holding meetings with its largest customers, mailing letters to several others, and issuing news releases to local media outlets. The prior commitment to our customers and associated publicity is the primary reason for the District's present request.

We certainly appreciate the Commission's consideration in this matter.
