ORDER

On November 26, 2012, Marion County Water District (“Marion District”) tendered to the Commission an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity and for authorization to enter an assistance agreement with Kentucky Infrastructure Authority. The tendered application contained a document entitled “Authorization for Electronic Deposit of Borrower Payment” that revealed Marion District’s employer tax identification and banking account numbers. Employer identification numbers and banking account numbers are considered confidential and exempted from disclosure under the Kentucky Open Records Act.¹

Accordingly, the Commission, on its own motion, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. The employer tax identification and banking account numbers appearing on the document entitled “Authorization for Electronic Deposit of Borrower Payment” is afforded confidential treatment.
2. The Executive Director shall transfer the document in question from the Commission’s public files to the Commission’s confidential files and shall place in the


