ORDER

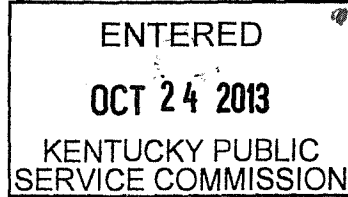
On May 8, 2013, Johnson County Gas Company ("Johnson County Gas") filed a motion to request that a portion of an Order dated November 29, 2012 ("Order") be modified. The Order directed Johnson County Gas to immediately establish an escrow account and to deposit "any GCA revenues collected in excess of actual monthly payments for the invoiced cost of gas purchases" from various suppliers, with the escrow to be used "to pay back billed invoices from Hall, Stephens & Hall." Johnson County Gas states that it opened the escrow account as directed, but since the revenues from all sources were insufficient to cover Johnson County Gas's operating expenses, Johnson County Gas was unable to deposit any money into the escrow account. Johnson County Gas's motion specified that it sought this relief only until the Commission ruled in Case No. 2012-00140. The Commission entered a final Order in Case No. 2012-00140 on June 18, 2013, and there was no request for rehearing and no appeal was taken from that Order.

Having reviewed Johnson County Gas's motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that Johnson County's motion became moot once the Commission's Order in Case No. 2012-00140 was entered on June 18, 2013. As there

is no longer an issue before the Commission, Johnson County's motion should be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Johnson County's motion is dismissed.
