ORDER

On December 20, 2013, as required by the Final Order in Case No. 2011-00440,¹ Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) submitted an updated report which describes its efforts to develop a new dynamic pricing or smart meter program and a report prepared by DNV KEMA addressing a smart meter strategy for LG&E and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”). The DNV KEMA report concludes that “. . . LG&E and KU may have opportunities to benefit from a targeted AMI deployment, but that system-wide conversion is not justified at this time given the data analyzed.”² LG&E asks that its next update be filed in June 2014 rather than March 2014 as it considers its options.

Having reviewed the request and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that LG&E has established good cause to permit it an extension of time in which to file its next update concerning its efforts to develop a new dynamic



pricing or smart meter program. The Commission will schedule an informal conference shortly after the next update is filed to further discuss LG&E's consideration of dynamic pricing and smart meter options and the DNV KEMA report.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:
