ORDER

A formal hearing in this matter was held on July 1 and July 8, 2014. At the conclusion of the hearing and in accordance with the Commission's April 7, 2014 Order, the parties, Harold Barker, Ann Barker and Brooks Barker ("Complainants") and East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") were directed to submit post-hearing briefs no later than August 1, 2014.

The Commission, on its own motion, finds that the parties should include in their briefs discussion regarding the possible range of remedies in this action and their requested relief. The parties should specifically address, with supporting legal authority, the possible remedies available in the event the Commission were to find a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") to be necessary for the transmission line project at issue. The Commission further finds that to fully address the aforesaid issues, the parties should be afforded an additional two weeks to brief the matter.

Finally, the Commission finds that the parties should include in their briefs an update on the status of any settlement negotiations that have taken place since the submission of EKPC's July 29, 2013 Offer of Settlement.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Complainants and EKPC shall submit post-hearing briefs no later than August 15, 2014.
- 2. Post-hearing briefs shall include discussion, with supporting legal authority, on the possible range of remedies available to the Commission in adjudicating this matter, including the available remedies in the event a CPCN were to be required for the project.
- 3. Post-hearing briefs shall include a report on the status of any settlement negotiations held since July 29, 2013.
