## ORDER

By Order entered July 24, 2014, the Commission ordered Harold Barker, Ann Barker and Brooks Barker ("Complainants") and East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("EKPC") to submit post-hearing briefs by August 15, 2014. Subsequent to their submission, EKPC moved on August 29, 2014, to strike certain portions of Complainants' brief, arguing that Complainants improperly presented new evidence in their brief.

On September 3, 2014, Complainants tendered a motion for an extension of time within which to respond to EKPC's motion. In support of their motion, they state that they were occupied by local Labor Day festivities, which precluded the submission of a response within the allotted seven-day time period. Accordingly, Complainants request an extension of time to file a response up to and including September 9, 2014.

The Commission finds that Complainants have demonstrated good cause for an extension of time to respond to EKPC's motion to strike.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Complainants motion for an extension of time is granted. Complainants shall submit their response to EKPC's motion to strike no later than September 9, 2014.
