I want to express my opposition and dismay to the announced intentions of AmeriGas to discontinue our current neighborhood gas service and replace it with individual residential tanks. I considered this system a major plus while looking to purchase in this community and hope this program will not be changed. Please consider;

1. Our neighborhood system is less than 6 years old and has received no complaints
2. We paid significant tap fees for the current system
3. This new idea will not improve the efficiency and is mainly driven to increase rates and profits for AmeriGas
4. Changes such as this should not be allowed without residential approval
5. We do not want individual tanks above or below ground on our lots
  - a. This will only decrease the property values and become a potential liability
6. Our current deed restrictions prohibit burial of tanks or unattached structures
  - a. These would be a major eye sore for the community
  - b. Tanks pose a major risk
