ORDER

On September 23, 2013, AmeriGas Partners, L.P. (“AmeriGas”) and AmeriGas Propane, L.P. (“AmeriGas Propane”) filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule entered on September 18, 2013, in order to initiate settlement discussions with Commission Staff.¹ The procedural schedule required AmeriGas, AmeriGas Propane, and Energy Transfer Partners, L.P (“Energy Transfer”) to file an answer within 20 days of the Commission’s September 18, 2013 show cause Order and to appear at a hearing on October 24, 2013. The Commission has not yet received a response from Energy Transfer to the show cause Order.

Based on the motion, as well as the need to preserve Energy Transfer’s due process rights, the Commission will grant a 45-day extension of time for each of the parties to either file a written response to the show cause Order or meet with Commission Staff to discuss a stipulation of facts and settlement. Additionally, based

on the motion to initiate settlement negotiations and the extension of time granted herein, the Commission will also continue the hearing scheduled for October 24, 2013.

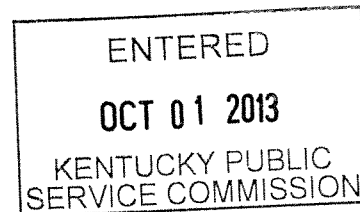
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The motion filed by AmeriGas and Amerigas Propane is granted to the extent that the Order entered September 18, 2013, is amended to require the parties to file a written response to the allegations contained in that Order within 45 days of the date of this Order.


2. The formal evidentiary hearing currently scheduled for October 24, 2013, is cancelled and shall be rescheduled if needed.

3. All other provisions of the Commission's September 18, 2013 Order shall remain in full force and effect.
