## <u>ORDER</u>

Hyden-Leslie County Water District ("Hyden-Leslie District") has requested authorization to borrow approximately \$2.4 million from Kentucky Rural Water Finance Corporation ("KRWFC") to finance the construction of a waterworks improvement project. We accepted Hyden-Leslie District's application for filing on November 27, 2013. KRS 278.300(2) requires that the Commission dispose of Hyden-Leslie District's application promptly within 60 days after its filing with the Commission "unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application for longer time than sixty (60) days."

Based upon our review of the existing evidence of record, the Commission finds that additional information regarding the proposed waterworks improvement project and Hyden-Leslie District's proposed plan of financing that project should be obtained. Accordingly, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the application generally beyond the statutory period of 60 days.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Hyden-Leslie District's application for authorization to enter a loan agreement with KRWFC is continued generally.
