ORDER

On December 2, 2013, Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos") requested a five-year extension of its financial hedging program, which the Commission had extended until March 31, 2014. - Unless a hearing is requested, this matter shall stand submitted on the record.
- 3. If a hearing is requested, no later than August 21, 2014, Atmos shall file with the Commission a list of the persons it intends to call as witnesses at the scheduled hearing and a summary of each witness's expected testimony.
