Kentucky Rural Water Association ("KRWA") has applied for accreditation and approval of its 2014 Management Conference, which will be held on February 19-20, 2014, in Bowling Green, Kentucky. This conference includes instruction on the Affordable Care Act, new water and wastewater technologies, workplace safety, integration of state and federal government surplus property programs into a water utility's procurement program, public communications, and leadership.

This Commission is required to "encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties."<sup>1</sup> Having reviewed KRWA's application, the Commission finds that the conference's presentations will enhance a water district commissioner's understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 9.0 hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA's 2014 Management Conference (WTS 2014-003), which will be held in Bowling Green, Kentucky, on February 19-20, 2014, is accredited and approved for a maximum of 9.0 credit hours of water district management training.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentation.

3. No later than March 20, 2014, KRWA shall file with the Commission:


a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;

b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and

c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
