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

RE: Informal Conference of July 17, 2014

Pursuant to Commission Staff's June 10, 2014 Notice, an informal conference was held in this matter on July 17, 2014. Attached is a copy of the attendance roster.

The informal conference was held jointly with the parties from Case Nos. 2013-00251¹ and 2013-00252² because all three cases involved an evidence of indebtedness issue. Each case had at least one issue in addition to the evidence of indebtedness issue. Representatives from the Frankfort Electric and Water Plant Board ("Frankfort Board") and South Anderson Water District ("SAWD") both gave permission to discuss issues relevant solely to Case No. 2013-00250 at the joint informal conference.

Frankfort Board indicated that the pump station is in place and ready to go. All work has been suspended pending resolution of the evidence of indebtedness issue. Infrastructure is not being used. Once the evidence of indebtedness issue is resolved, the spigot could immediately be turned on. SAWD is ready to implement the contract.

The parties were advised that the Commission is aware of the parties' concern regarding the delay in a decision being issued. Commission Staff indicated that a decision would be issued as quickly as possible regarding the evidence of indebtedness issue.

Ms. Ramser told the parties that the Commission Staff had concerns about how Frankfort Board would spend the \$242,264 being advanced by SAWD. One reason for the \$242,264 being advanced by SAWD is for the Frankfort Board's pump station which is to serve SAWD and correct pressure issues within Frankfort Board's system.

There being no further issued, the informal conference then ended.
