ORDER

On December 13, 2013, in Case No. 2013-00167,¹ the Commission approved rates for Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc. ("Columbia") and provided for their further adjustment in accordance with Columbia's Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA") clause.

On January 29, 2014, Columbia filed its proposed GCA to be effective February 28, 2014.

After reviewing the record in this case and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that:

- 1. Columbia's notice includes rates designed to pass on to its customers its expected change in wholesale gas costs.
- 2. Columbia's Expected Gas Cost ("EGC") is \$6.2363 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.1932 per Mcf from its previous EGC of \$6.0431 per Mcf that was approved in GCA Case No. 2013-00382.²
- 3. Columbia's notice sets out a rate for Banking and Balancing Service of \$.0204 per Mcf.

- 4. Columbia's notice sets out no current quarter supplier Refund Adjustment ("RA"). Columbia's notice sets out a total RA of (\$.0081) per Mcf, which represents no change from its previous total RA.
- 5. Columbia's notice sets out its Actual Cost Adjustment ("ACA") of \$.4847 per Mcf, which represents no change from its previous ACA.
- 6. Columbia's notice sets out its Balancing Adjustment ("BA") of (\$1.0504) per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$1.0329 per Mcf from its previous BA of (\$.0175) per Mcf.
- 7. Columbia's notice sets out a Special Agency Service refund adjustment of (\$.0003) per Mcf, which represents no change from its previous Special Agency Service refund adjustment.
- 8. Columbia's notice sets out its Gas Cost Incentive Adjustment ("GCIA") of \$.0189 per Mcf, which is an increase of \$.0081 per Mcf from its previous GCIA of \$.0108 per Mcf.
- 9. Columbia's approved Gas Cost Recovery rate ("GCR") is \$5.6811 per Mcf, which is a decrease of \$.8316 per Mcf from the previous GCR of \$6.5127 per Mcf that was approved in GCA Case No 2013-00382.
- 10. The rate in the Appendix to this Order is fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved for billing for the March 2014 billing cycle, beginning on February 28, 2014.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rate in the Appendix to this Order is approved for billing with the final meter readings beginning on February 28, 2014.

2. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Columbia shall file with this Commission, using the Commission's electronic Tariff Filing System, revised tariff sheets setting out the rate approved herein and reflecting that it was approved pursuant to this Order.
