ORDER

Kentucky Rural Water Association (“KRWA”) has applied for accreditation and approval of its Water and Wastewater Operator Training held on June 4 and 5, 2014, in Whitley City, Kentucky. This conference provided instruction on various water and wastewater facility processes and procedures.

This Commission is required to “encourage and promote the offering of high quality water district management training programs that enhance a water district commissioner’s understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties.”<sup>1</sup> Having reviewed KRWA’s application, the Commission finds that the conference’s presentations enhance a water district commissioner’s understanding of his or her responsibilities and duties and should be accredited for 12 hours of water district management training.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. KRWA’s Water and Wastewater Operator Training held on June 4 and 5, 2014, in Whitley City, Kentucky, is accredited and approved for a maximum of 12 credit hours of water district management training.

2. KRWA shall retain a record of all water district commissioners attending the accredited and approved presentation.

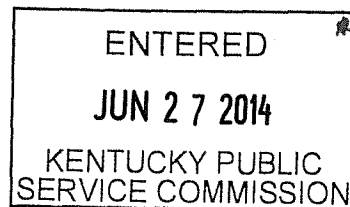
3. No later than August 4, 2014, KRWA shall file with the Commission:

a. A sworn statement attesting that the accredited instruction was performed;

b. A description of any changes in the presenters or the proposed curriculum that occurred after KRWA's application; and

c. The name of each attending water district commissioner, his or her water district, and the number of hours that he or she attended.
