ORDER

Taylor County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Taylor RECC") tendered its application in this matter with the Commission on June 10, 2014. In its application, Taylor RECC requested an effective date of July 6, 2014, for its proposed Section EDR, Economic Development Rider ("EDR") tariff. Pursuant to KRS 278.180(1), no change can be made by a utility in any rate except upon 30 days' notice to the Commission. Since KRS 278.180(1) requires Taylor RECC to provide the Commission with 30 days' notice of any change in rates, the earliest its proposed rates can become effective is July 10, 2014.

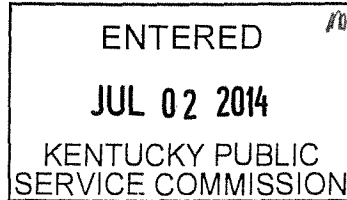
Based on a review of Taylor County's application, the Commission finds that an investigation will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff and that the investigation cannot be concluded by July 10, 2014. Therefore, pursuant to KRS 278.190(2), the Commission will suspend the proposed effective date for five months from July 10, 2014, up to and including December 9, 2014.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. Taylor RECC's proposed effective date of its EDR tariff is suspended for five months from July 10, 2014, the earliest date that the EDR tariff can become effective, up to and including December 9, 2014.

2. Nothing shall prevent the Commission from issuing further Orders prior to the end of the suspension period.
