ORDER

Complainant, Mary Geisler Domigan ("Ms. Domigan"), initiated the instant proceeding alleging that Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") had overcharged her in calculating a back bill for unbilled water usage covering the period of January 23, 2013, to January 23, 2014. On June 17, 2014, the Commission issued an Order to Kentucky-American to file an answer or satisfy the Complaint within ten days. On July 1, 2014, Ms. Domigan filed a letter voluntarily withdrawing the Complaint and requesting that the matter be closed. The Commission will treat the letter as a motion to withdraw the Complaint. As a basis for this motion, Ms. Domigan stated that she reached a mutually acceptable resolution with Kentucky-American regarding the back bill charges.

Having reviewed the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that the motion to dismiss should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Complainant's motion to dismiss is granted and this case shall be dismissed with prejudice and removed from the Commission's docket.
