ORDER

On June 2, 2014, Tracy Mathis (“Ms. Mathis”) filed a formal Complaint against Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) alleging that a power line that runs diagonally across her property to a neighbor’s house presents a safety issue. On June 17, 2014, the Commission issued an Order for LG&E to file an answer or satisfy the Complaint within ten days. On June 27, 2014, LG&E filed a Motion for an Extension of Time until July 7, 2014, to file its answer or satisfy the complaint. As a basis for this Motion, LG&E states that it is working with Ms. Mathis to reach a mutually acceptable resolution to the issues presented in the complaint.

The Commission finds that the Motion is timely filed and that the extension of time to file an answer or satisfy the complaint should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The Motion for an Extension of Time to file an answer or satisfy the Complaint is granted.
