## ORDER

On June 10, 2014, Kenergy Corp. ("Kenergy") submitted a tariff filing requesting approval of an amendment to a retail electric service agreement ("Amendment") between Kenergy and Pennyrile Energy, LLC ("Pennyrile"). The Amendment was executed on March 21, 2014. The filing also consisted of a cover letter and a letter of agreement signed by Kenergy's wholesale power supplier, Big Rivers Electric Corporation, consenting to the Amendment. The Amendment indicates that Kenergy is the retail electric supplier to Pennyrile, that Pennyrile entered into an agreement for electric service dated February 15, 2013, and effective April 5, 2013, and that Kenergy and Pennryile agreed to amend Pennyrile's retail electric service agreement by reducing the maximum contract demand and establishing a minimum contract demand. Kenergy requests that the Commission approve the proposed Amendment effective June 30, 2014.

Having reviewed the tariff filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.180(1), Kenergy must give the Commission 30 days' notice prior to implementing the Amendment to the retail electric service agreement between Kenergy and Pennryile. Since the only retail customer

affected by this Amendment has consented in writing to all of the terms, the Commission finds good cause to reduce the notice period to 20 days. Consequently, the Amendment shall become effective on June 30, 2014. The Commission further finds that the terms of the proposed Amendment are reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed Amendment to the retail electric service contract between Kenergy and Pennyrile, as described in the findings above, is accepted for service effective June 30, 2104.
